## Call for Abstracts

The Conference Program Committee is inviting abstracts for the 6th ACiNE Conference "New Frontiers in Nursing Education: Bridging Technology and Practice" to be held in Brisbane on the 17<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> November 2025. The Scientific Committee encourages the submission of abstracts reporting on in-progress or completed nursing education studies or innovations in the following presentation categories:

- 15-minute Oral presentations (12-minute presentation and 3-minute questions);
- 6-minute Speed talks; and/or
- Poster Presentations.

In-progress research is eligible for a poster presentation and/or a 6-minute speed talk, while a completed study is eligible for consideration as an oral presentation.

We encourage abstracts from first time presenters, early and mid career academics, as well as students.

**Oral or Poster Abstracts:** Abstracts for a poster or 15-minute oral presentation are invited for submission under one of the following categories:

- **Teaching and learning Innovation**
  - Interprofessional Education
  - Simulation
  - Clinical
  - Curriculum design
  - Learning and teaching approaches
  - Assessment approaches
- **Practice**
  - Sustainable Development Goals
  - Chronic and Chronic Illnesses
  - Evidence-based Practice
  - Patient education
  - Professional Development
- **New Horizons**
  - Generative AI
  - Planetary Health
  - Graduate Retention
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**Six-minute speed talks:** Recently commenced T&L innovations or research projects are invited to be submitted as a six-minute speed talk.

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## **Abstract Submission Guidelines & Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Preparation of Abstract**

Abstracts are to be prepared according to the following guidelines:

- No more than 2 abstracts as lead author can be submitted.
- The presentation is to be evidence or practice-based with practical application.
- It is a condition of having your abstract accepted and included in the Conference Program that you are a registered and paid delegate. The presenting author(s) will be required to register for the Conference by September 12th, 2025, in order to ensure their abstract is included in the final program.
- Only abstracts submitted online will be accepted.
- Submission constitutes consent to publication of the abstract in the Conference Proceedings publication, which will be uploaded to the conference website.
- Following acceptance of the abstract, poster presentations are to be submitted online, in A4 word format, by September 19th, 2025, so that they can be uploaded to the conference website following the conference. Instructions for online submission will be sent to successful authors.

### **Abstract Format:**

Body of abstract is not to exceed 250 words, including sub-headings, excluding the title, author(s) names, institutional affiliation(s) and any references, font Arial 11, regular, justified; indentation: none; line spacing: single; paragraph spacing: none.

Abstracts are to be written using the following subheadings:

- Introduction/Background/Significance
- Aims/Objectives/Hypothesis/Goals or Problem
- Methods
- Results
- Discussion/Implications for practice
- Conclusion
- Conflict of interest (where applicable)
- Funding acknowledgement (where applicable)

Abstracts are to be free of typographical and grammatical errors as they will be published as submitted.

Abstracts open for submission in the week commencing 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025 and will close on 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2025.

Notification of outcomes is expected in early September 2025.
